The school offers competitive salaries and a strong benefits plan, which includes full medical benefits, a retirement TIAA-CREF plan, life insurance, and New York City Metro Cards to underwrite transportation costs. Another benefit is our school lunch program, which provides a delicious, locally-sourced, and nutritious lunch to all children, faculty, and staff members.
